Nantasket Beach

Known as one of New England's Best Beaches, it's only 10 minutes from Hingham, located on the Hull Peninsula

Grape Island

Walk through a wildlife haven known for its wild berries, birds, and natural beauty. The island almost doubles in size at low tide.

Lovell's Island

The nearest island to sites of legendary shipwrecks. Tour the gun batteries, bunkers, and foundations of Fort Standish. Put on your water shoes and wade along a rocky beach or explore tide pools with views of the outer islands and Boston Light.

Samuel Adams Brewery

Located only 20 minutes from Hingham and south of Boston, visit the brewery where over 6 Generations have made brewing a tradition.

Other Attractions

Shop at the Derby Street Shops, play a round at one of the many golf courses around the bay area, or visit Fenway Park, home of the legendary Green Monster & the Red Sox, less than 40 minutes off of 93.

Bay Area Attractions

Boston Harbor Islands

Peddock's Island (Mooring Available)

Home of Fort Andrews, previously a sub-post of Fort Strong on Long Island, Peddock's Island is a rare example of a relatively intact coastal fort of the Endicott Period (1888-1905).

George's Island (Mooring Available)

Home of historic Fort Warren, a Civil War-era fort known for its graceful granite archways and reputed ghost, the Lady in Black. Take a ranger-guided tour or visit the new museum. Free water shuttle to other islands.
